

Taxpayers are required to file and pay Motor Fuel electronically. File and pay through the Motor Fuel Online Reporting System at zytax.dor.sc.gov.

You can also submit payments on MyDORWAY.dor.sc.gov, our secure online tax portal. Create a MyDORWAY account or login to get started. If you do not file and pay electronically, a penalty of \$5,000 per filing period will apply. This electronic mandate went into effect March 1, 2019.

This document provides general information about the Motor Fuel Terminal Operator Annual Return.

WHO NEEDS TO FILE

• Motor Fuel Terminal Operators for South Carolina locations only

WHEN TO FILE

- **Due date:** The Motor Fuel Terminal Operators Annual Return is due by February 26 of the year following the filing period. (For example, your 2020 return is due on February 26, 2021.)
- You must file a Motor Fuel Terminal Operators Annual Return even if you have no tax liability for the year.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED WHEN YOU FILE

You will need the following information for the filing period:

- Your Motor Fuel License Number and Federal Employer ID Number (FEIN)
 - Your Net Gallons Lost, Net Gallons Gained, and Gallons Removed for each month for:
 - o Gasoline/Gasohol
 - o Undyed Diesel/Biodiesel
 - Other/Substitute Fuels
 - o Dyed Fuel
 - Undyed/Dyed Kerosene
 - Aviation Gasoline
 - o Jet Fuel
